We are inviting people with Cerebral Palsy to contribute health information to the New Zealand Cerebral Palsy Register.

What is the NZ Cerebral Palsy Register?

- A database of clinical information about Cerebral Palsy (CP)
- We aim to collect information from everybody with CP in NZ
- Type of information includes: your birth history; description of CP and your physical abilities
- There will be NO new tests or measures for you to do

What are the possible benefits of the Register?

If everyone contributes their data we will be able to:

- Know how many people have CP in NZ and how it affects them
- Improve health and education planning for people with CP
- Promote research in the field of CP care
- Compare our practice to overseas experience

How can I participate?

Participation in the NZCP Register is voluntary. Any person with CP and their families can be enrolled. To get all the NZCP Register information:
